The hotel lobby dates from the year 1600 and is indeed the oldest part of the hotel building. It was originally built by Don Juan de Peralta, the Consul of the County of Navarra in Spain, as his

official residence during the Spanish occupation of the Flanders region.

Between 1795 and 1802, under French rule, the interior was entirely redecorated in Empire style. The present triumphal staircase was especially built for an official visit by Emperor Napoleon I to

Bruges, when he was supposed to stay at the hotel. However, in the end Napoleon did not spend the night in Bruges.

Today our Front Desk is actually situated in the lobby and welcomes many guests from all over!

The History of Best Western Premier Hotel Navarra

Best Western Premier Hotel Navarra - Bruges - The History - The Consul of Navarra

1600-1715 Don Juan de Peralta (b June 22, 1549), Consul of the Spanish Province of Navarra as well as Alderman of Bruges, built his official residence on the site of the present hotel. He

lies buried next to his wife Maria Lauwers, in the adjoining St Jakobschurch, behind the main altar, under a white slab. They had three children: Jean, Anne and Marie. Marie continued to reside at

the hotel and married Jean Pardo, the Mayor of Bruges. Their youngest daughter Alexandrine married Charles-Francois-Louis de Schoote, Lord of Marckhove, Alderman of Finances in Bruges and member of

the States General of Flanders. Consequently the building came into the possession of the Van Marckhove family.

1715 The premises were bought by 'de Gilde der Makelaars' (the State Agents' Guild), and became its headquarters.

1720 The name was changed into 'Hotel des Courtiers', and the premises were completely rebuilt in the style of Louis XV. The name was changed once more into 'Cour de Commerce', under the rule of

Maria-Theresia of Austria.

1781 Emperor Jozef II of Austria stayed at the hotel from June 13 till June 15 during an official visit to Bruges, when he participated in the Blessed Sacrament Procession, carrying a flaming

torch. On August 29 Duke Albert Casimir, Governor-General of the United Netherlands and his wife the Duchess Marie-Augustine of Austria, were also guests at the hotel.

Best Western Premier Hotel Navarra - Bruges- The History - Napoleon

1795-1802 After the battle of Fleurus, the 'Cour de Commerce', now under French rule, was sold and transformed into the 'Tribunal de Commerce'. Only part of the building was used for this

purpose however. The remainder was used to house the 'Hotel du Commerce', as well as a 'Cour de Commerce' (Commercial Court). The present triumphal staircase and the beautiful Bonaparte halls were

especially built for an official visit by Emperor Napoleon I to Bruges when he was supposed to stay at the hotel. However, in the end Napoleon did not spend the night in Bruges. The halls in the

hotel were regularly used for important meetings during the reign of William of Orange.

1802 The Vanden Berghe-Dumortier family became the new owners of the hotel and ran it for a full one hundred and eighteen years as a first class hotel.

1842-1914 'The Commercial Court' moved to the Palace of Justice and the 16th-century house in the inner courtyard was supplemented with a 19th-century moulded façade. The masterly wrought-

iron entrance gate also dates from this period. From this time onwards, the premises were used only as a hotel and bore the name of 'Grand Hotel du Commerce'. The hotel had about 60 rooms and was

especially popular amongst British visitors, who later on were also able to

enjoy the comforts of electric lighting, central heating, a beautiful garden, car park, and a private shuttle service to

and from the station. All this was quite unique for that time ! Many famous guests, including the poet Longfellow who is well-known for his poem entitled 'The Belfry of Bruges', stayed at the

hotel.

1914-1918 During the first weeks of 'World War I', the owner placed his hotel at the disposal of 'the Red Cross'. After this, it was taken over by officers of the German Army. After the

Armistice, the Grand Hotel was temporarily used as the Official Headquarters of the Belgian Government from October 31 till November 21, 1918, following their return from exile.

1920-1950 The hotel was sold to the Pauwels-D'Hondt family. In 1924 the oldest part of the building dating from 1600 was raised with a mansard roof.

1950-1981 The hotel was sold to the City of Bruges, to be used as a residence for students of the newly founded 'Europacollege'.

1981 The premises were in a pitiful state and in view of high renovation costs, the City decided to sell it to Michel Maertens, to be transformed once again into a hotel.

1982 Hotel Navarra opened its doors on the January 01 as a four-star hotel with 64 rooms. Through the acquisition of adjacent premises, the hotel became one of the most famous hotels, situated

in the historic city centre of Bruges with 87 rooms.

1996 Hotel Navarra was officially declared a Historic Monument.

2000 The premises have been in existence for precisely 400 years and after years of restoration have once again been restored to their former magnificence.

2002 The year in which Bruges is 'Cultural Capital of Europe', together with the Spanish city of Salamanca. During that year, Hotel Navarra celebrated its 20th anniversary.

2005 Through the acquisition of adjacent premises, the hotel has now 94 rooms.

Market Square area

\* Belfry Tower and Halles

The city's most remarkable landmark. Climbing the 366 steps of the winding staircase is a challenge: on top of the tower you are rewarded with an amazing view. On the second storey is the

former medieval treasure-room, today a museum. The Belfry's carillon (47 bells with a total weight of 27 tons) is one of the finest in the world. Concerts are played on it three times a week.

\* Jan Breydel & Pieter De Coninck

Statue of two popular local heroes, who played a leading part in the resistance against the French occupying powers in 1302.

\* Provincial Government Palace

Neo-gothic building (1887-1921), former seat of West Flanders' Provincial Council.

Burg Square area

\* Basilica of the Holy Blood

Double chapel. On the ground level - St. Basil's Chapel (1139-1149) in roman style. The first floor chapel, converted into neo-gothic style in the 19th century, contains a.o. the famous Relic

of the Holy Blood. Museum of the Holy Blood: exhibition of reliquaries, vestments, paintings and other artefacts.

\* City Hall

- \* Groeninge Museum (Dijver 12)

This museum houses a comprehensive and fascinating survey of six centuries of Flemish, Dutch and Belgian paintings, from Jan van Eyck to Marcel Broodthaers. The museum's many highlights

include the world-famous collection of 'Flemish Primitive' art, works by a wide range of Renaissance and Baroque masters, a selection of paintings from the 18th & 19th century, Neo-classical and

Realist periods, milestones of Belgian Symbolism and Modernism, masterpieces of Flemish Expressionism and many items from the city's collection of postwar modern art.

- \* Gruuthuse Museum (Dijver 17)

Located in the former palace of the Lords of Gruuthuse, this museum contains a most varied collection of decorative art. A large collection of sculptures, Bruges tapestries, furniture,

silverware, ceramics and coins is displayed. The magnificent interior will take you back to the late Middle Ages.

- \* Brangwyn Museum / Arentshuis (Dijver 16)

This magnificent 18th-century mansion, located at the entrance to a picturesque garden, is dedicated to Frank Brangwyn (1867-1956), a versatile artist of British nationality who was born in

Bruges. The ground floor is the location for a varied programme of visual arts exhibitions (associated with the Groeninge collection)

- \* Memling Museum (Mariastraat 38)

This recently restored museum is housed in one of the oldest surviving medieval hospitals in Europe (12th-17th century). Everyday life at the hospital is reconstructed in the magnificent

historic wards by a collection of paintings, sculptures, furniture and decorative art. The adjacent church is the hospital's undisputed treasure-room, containing as it does several brilliant 15th-

century paintings and the St. Ursula Shrine, all by Hans Memling. The 17th-century pharmacy has been completely preserved in the former monastery.

\* Church of Our Lady (Mariastraat)

This church (13th-15th century) with a 118 m (approx. 400 feet) high tower, can boast an array of art treasures: paintings, wood sculptures, the white marble Madonna and Child by

Michelangelo, the 16th-century mausoleums of Charles the Bold and Mary of Burgundy and some remarkable painted tombs (13th-14th century) in the presbytery.

\* Gothic Hall - City Hall (Burg Square)

The Gothic Hall on the first floor of Bruges City Hall is open to the public. This former council chamber continues to play an important part in city life. The wooden, polychrome, vaulted

ceiling is decorated with a profusion of late medieval carvings. The murals, illustrating Bruges' glorious past, were added during the chamber's restoration in the late 19th century. The adjoining

'historical chamber' contains several objects, documents and works of art with a bearing on the city's past.

\* Liberty of Bruges (Brugse Vrije, Burg 11a)

The Bruges countryside was originally governed from here, then this stately home acted as a Courthouse. Today the oldest wing (16th century) contains the city archive and in the Renaissance

Room you can admire the monumental mantelpiece.

\* Belfry (Markt 7)

The medieval Belfry Tower (13th-15th century) is 83 metres tall (approx. 289 feet) and houses the former city treasury, in which Bruges' valuables (money and royal charters) were once kept. A

climb of 366 steps will take you to the impressive clock mechanism. Once you've reached the carillon with its 47 bells, you can enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the city and its surroundings.

\* Archeological Museum (Mariastraat 36a)

This museum contains a wide variety of material witnesses to Bruges' past, discovered during excavations in the city centre and in the outskirts. Pottery, glass, leather and crypts illustrate

the city's history from the Stone Age to the Middle Ages and beyond.

\* Folklore Museum (Balstraat 43)

The restored and picturesque 17th century almshouses, which used to belong to the cobblers' guild, evoke the atmosphere of the past. Historic objects are used to reconstruct a classroom, a

cobbler's workshop and a chemist, a confectionery, etc. You can round off your tour at the museum inn, 'The Black Cat'.

\* Museum of Our Lady of the Potterie (Potterierei 79)

This museum is located in a historical hospital complex (14th-17th century). Its numerous paintings and sculptures alone are worth a visit, but the museum also contains furniture from the

Gothic to Baroque era. The adjoining church can boast one of the city's best

preserved Baroque interiors and houses a wealth of art treasures.

\* Sint-Janshuismolen / Koelweimolen (windmills) (Krui svest)

Ever since their completion in the 13th century and until the 19th century, Bruges' outer ramparts were dotted with windmills. Nowadays, 2 windmills dominate the 'Krui svest'. The St.

Janshuismolen, which dates from 1770, is the only mill that has remained in its original position. Both windmills are still operational and are used to grind flour.

\* Guido Gezelle Museum (Rolweg 64)

The literary and biographical museum of Guido Gezelle (1830-1899), one of Flanders' best-known poets, is located in the house in which the writer was born. The museum has been completely

renewed and redecorated in view of the 'Guido Gezelle Year' (1999). Documents, books and souvenirs reconstruct the life and work of this poet-priest. The house has a large romantic garden and is

located in a peaceful, typical city quarter.

\* Bruges Diamond Museum (Katelijnestraat 43)

The theme of this museum is the extraordinary history of Bruges as Europe's oldest diamond centre. Visitors can find out about the mysterious world of the diamond, one of Belgium's most

important export products. Open daily till 05.30 pm. Diamond-cutting demonstrations - daily at 12.15 pm.

\* Chocolate Museum - Choco-Story (Wijnzakstraat 2)

A great experience! You are immersed in the ancient Mexican world of the Mayas and the Aztecs for whom chocolate was the drink of the gods and cacao beans a means of payment. The chocoholic

gets to find out all about the production of chocolate truffles, chocolates, hollow figures and bars of chocolate. Lots of information but also very interactive and child friendly.

\* Frietmuseum (Vlamingstraat 33)

This museum dedicated to the history of Belgian fries will be located in the Saalhal, one of Bruges' oldest and best preserved historical buildings (1399). The Frietmuseum is unique in the

world. It is the first museum that shows the entire history, from the origin of the potato to the first fries. Visitors will be able to see an interesting collection of machines used for the

cultivation, harvesting, peeling, sorting and frying of potatoes. The museum will, however, also focus on Belgian fries in art, in music and on film. After the museum tour, the visitors will be

able to taste the real Belgian fries, with delicious sauces and all sorts of meat preparations, in the medieval basement.

\* Lace Centre (Peperstraat 3a)

A lace museum in the beautifully restored almshouses 'Jerusalem' (a 15th century foundation established by the Genoese merchants Adornes). It is in the former family house that lacemaking

demonstrations are given every afternoon.

\* Lamp Museum - Lumina Domestica (Wijnzakstraat 2)

This museum focuses exclusively on the history of interior lighting. It houses the world's largest lamp collection.

You can buy a combination ticket for the chocolate + lamp museum.

\* Museum-Gallery Xpo Salvador Dali (Markt 7)

Within the Belfry of Bruges, you can visit an exhibition of art created by

the celebrated artist Salvador Dalí.

Bruges is renowned for its very rich cultural heritage, its world-class museums, fascinating events, a cosy pleasant overall atmosphere and for its shopping and dining facilities, but also offers

some surprising additional attractions, such as:

\* The Brewery 'De Halve Maan' (Walplein 26)

This brewery, already mentioned in 1546, produces the 'Brugse Zot' and the 'Straffe Hendrik' beer that you can try here. During one of the guided visits you will learn more about production

methods and the history of the brewery.

\* St. Sebastian's Archers' Guild (Carmenstraat 174)

The members of this ancient and honourable long-bow archers' guild treasure valuable paintings, important archives and reminders of the membership of Belgian and British monarchs.

\* St. George's Archers Guild (Stijn Streuvelsstraat 59)

The crossbow archers of St. George's preserve valuable archives as well as a unique collection of crossbows.

\* Almshouses

Almshouses are old houses which were built by the guilds for their members and their widows or as a deed of charity by wealthy burghers for the poor and the elderly. The oldest houses date

from the 14th century. They are very often built around a communal garden with a small chapel and a well. The most remarkable examples are: Almshouse 'De Vos' (Noordstraat), 'De Pelikaan' (Groene

Rei), 'Zorghe' and 'Schipppers' (Stijn Streuvelsstraat), 'the Rooms Couvent' (Katelijnestraat), 'De Meulenaere' and 'Sint-Jozef' (Nieuwe Gentweg). These institutions have been owned by the city

since the French revolution. Most complexes have been restored and modernised and are still inhabited by elderly people. Most of the inner gardens are open to the public.

\* Boudewijn 'Seapark' & 'Dolfinarium'

Themepark, situated just outside Bruges, including a dolfinarium.

## Major cultural platforms:

- \* The 'Concertgebouw' (Concert Hall) (Zand Square)

This building is inseparably linked with the 'European City of Culture of 2002' project. The design criteria for the concert hall are related to openness and adventure, innovation and modern

image, but also to functionality. An eye-catching feature is the so-called 'Lantern Tower', which is slightly separate from the main volume and overlooks the Zand Square. In this tower is a chamber

music hall with 300 seats. In the actual concert building the large auditorium seats 1300. Top quality attractions in the area of classical music, jazz, musical theatre, visual arts, ... take place

yearround. For more details regarding programmes and on-line ticketing, click through to the website of the Concertgebouw.

- \* The 'Stadsschouwburg' (City Theatre) (Vlamingstraat)

The neo-Renaissance theatre was built in 1868 and was recently completely renovated. A unique historical decor inside.

The statue in front of the theatre represents Papageno, the cheerful bird-fancier from Mozart's opera 'The Magic Flute'. Opposite, across the street is a copper-engraved score from the same

opera.
